

## PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID

### Overview:

This course offers accreditation to workers in the early years sector, whilst also giving training in essential adult care where they differ from those of infants and children. The knowledge you will gain from this course can make the difference between temporary or permanent injury and the difference between life and death. Learning to perform first aid is an interactive process that requires a combination of compassion, skill and knowledge. The practice sessions incorporated into the training course gives you the competence and confidence to provide emergency first aid when called to do so.

  - *Physical Assessment*
- Accident Recording & Your First Aid Kit
- Guidance for treatment of the following
  - *Head injury, fractures, eye injury, burns, exposure to extreme heat and cold, respiratory problems, allergic reactions, seizures, poisoning, meningitis, diabetes and more.*
